Why migrate?

- Its open source
- Uses ISO standard file format (ODF)
- Available in over 70 languages
- Cross-platform
- Support available

Is it cost effective?

- Initial purchase/outlay cost
 - Microsoft Office Professional 2003: RM1,710
 - Corel WordPerfect Office: RM1,097
 - IBM Lotus SmartSuite R9.8: RM650
 - Sun StarOffice 8: RM278
 - OpenOffice.org: **Free download**

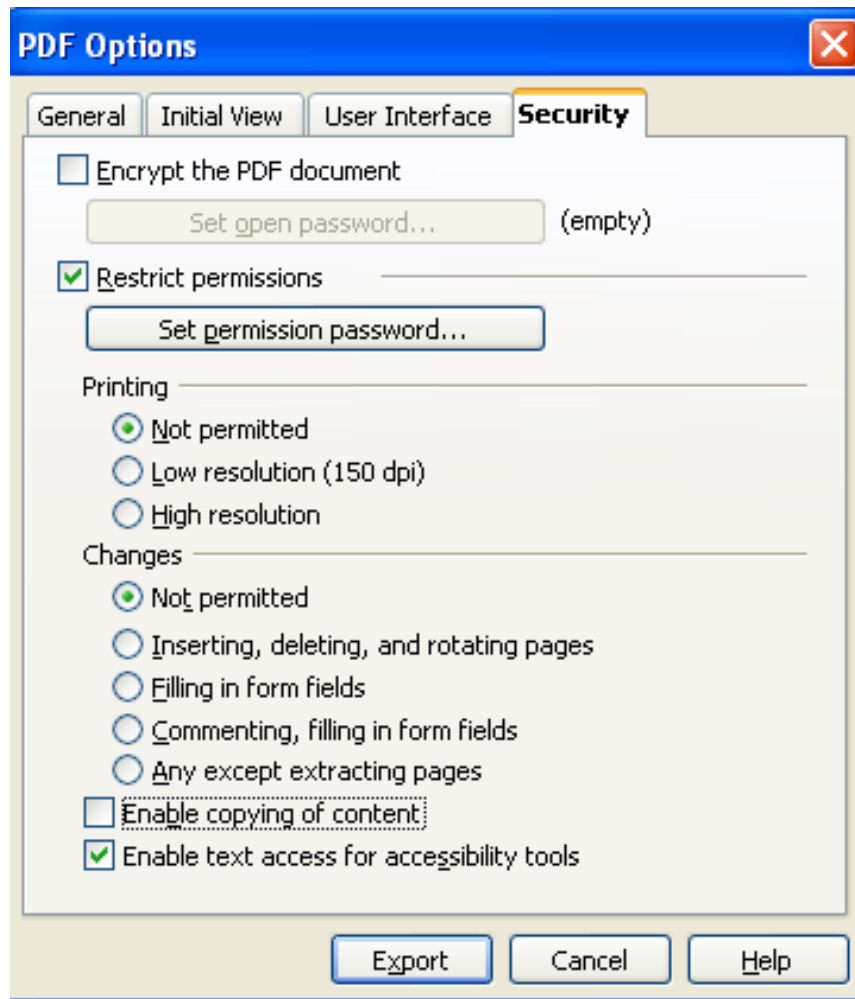
Is it cost effective?

- Saves on ongoing licenses and upgrades
- Re-training costs similar, if not cheaper
- Changeover support, and support in general available from ISVs
- Data/document conversions
 - Between Office versions
 - From Office to OpenOffice.org (use ODF!)

What's missing?

- Integrated unabridged dictionary & thesaurus
- Grammar checker
- File interoperability & filters
- VBA Macros
- Varied clip-art & templates

The power of PDF

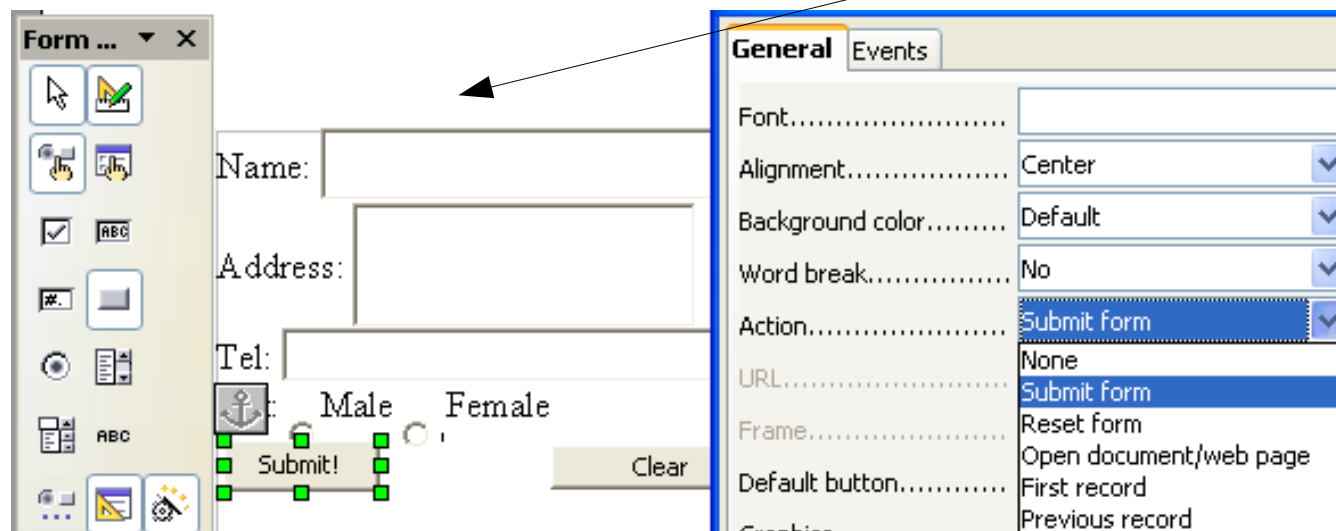


- All applications have the export to PDF functionality
- Advanced options are available as well
 - No printing
 - No copying
- No editing

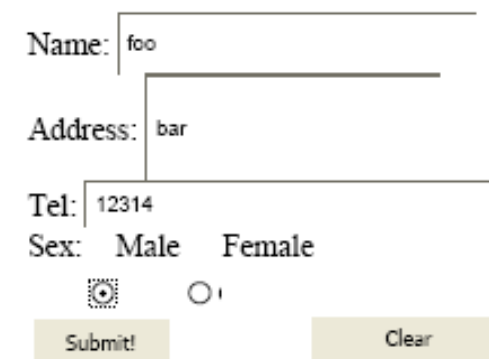
PDF Forms

- Create forms that can be filled up in a standard PDF reader and submitted via the Web or printed

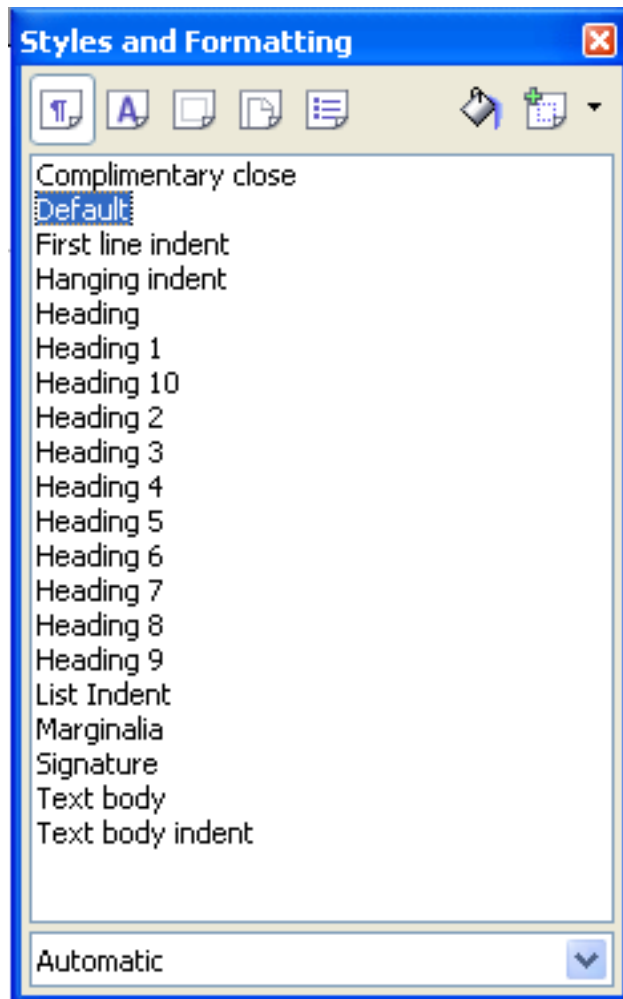
Creating a form in

Word vs. Writer



- Styles are how OpenOffice.org handles management of varying formats in the document
- Format Paintbrush
 - Was missing, is implemented now!



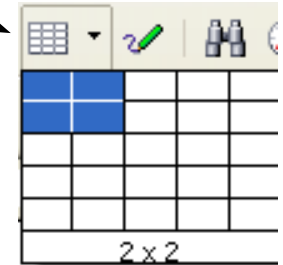

Word vs. Writer

- Tables are the same
 - Creation via Insert, as opposed to a dedicated menu
 - Has AutoFormat abilities
 - Can be used to enter formulae
- Fields
 - Standard, Extended, and also Data Source (i.e. Pull data from a database)

Can also be created via the toolbar quickly (Ctrl+F12 is another)



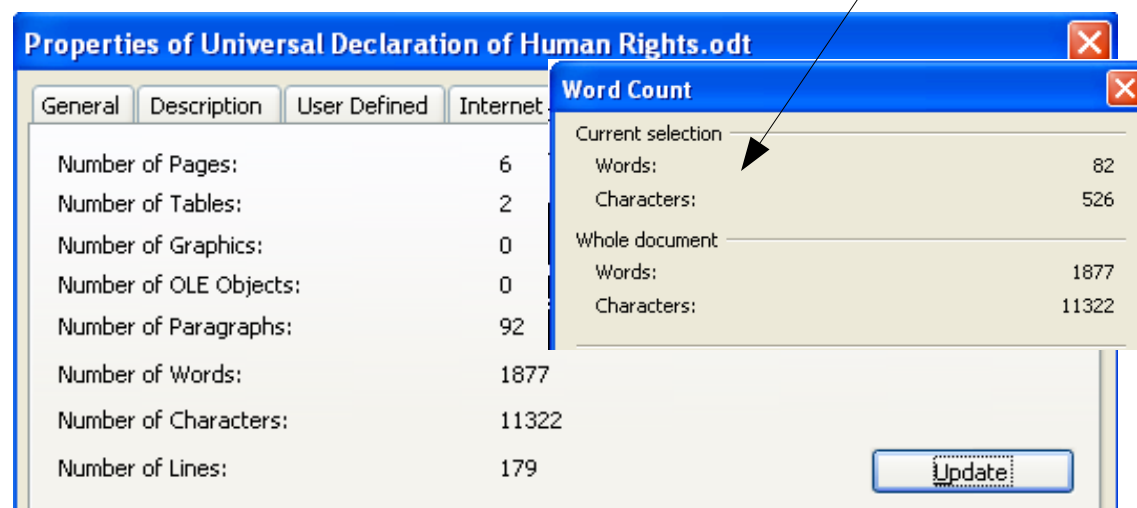
Word vs. Writer

- Object insertion
 - Insert -> Object -> Choose an object
- Word Count
 - Fixed via File -> Properties -> Statistics

Notice count for selection!

Excel vs. Calc

- No more row limitation – 65536 rows!
- Complex statistical functions might be unavailable
- Which is correct?
 - =IF(C3 > 0, D1+D2, D1-D2) <- Excel
 - =IF(C3 > 0; D1+D2; D1-D2) <- Calc

This is one of the most common differences that will affect you. Take note of the “;” instead of the “,”!

Excel vs. Calc

- DataPilot (instead of the Pivot Table)
 - Can do statistical analysis on data independent of the sheet/cells (spreadsheet) **but also** data sources!

Features of confusion

- When apply filters, my totals change?
 - SUBTOTAL(range): adjust totals based on filter
 - TOTAL(range): total that ignores filters
- FIND or SEARCH?
 - FIND(search,text): substring, standard text match
 - SEARCH(search,text): regular expressions allowed

PowerPoint vs. Impress

- Animated sequences, multimedia plug-in's not Impress's strong points
 - Requires Java Media Framework
- Export to Flash, layers, and live data sources are
- Limited templates
- Can also create via Writer (styles)
 - File -> Send -> AutoAbstract to Presentation

Access vs. Base

- File incompatibility
- All is not lost
 - Use the MySQL Migration Toolkit
 - Convert Access to MySQL (locally running, or on a server)
 - Manipulate data using Base, connecting to MySQL
- Benefits are a plenty – web access to your DB!

Base displays and edits the migrated Access database, directly to MySQL.

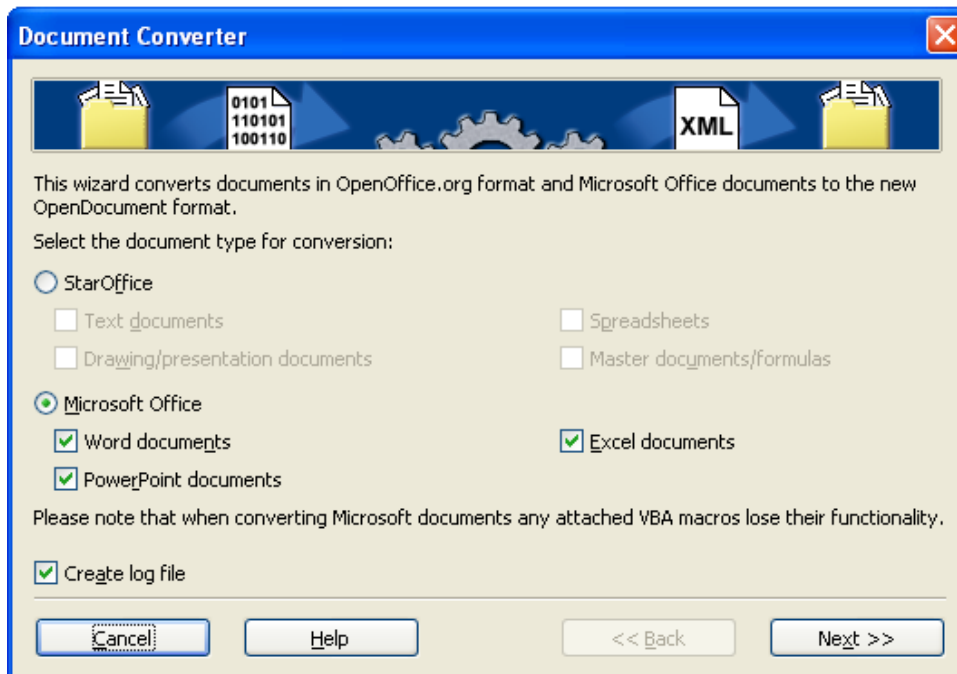

What's missing?

- Integrated unabridged dictionary & thesaurus
- Grammar checker
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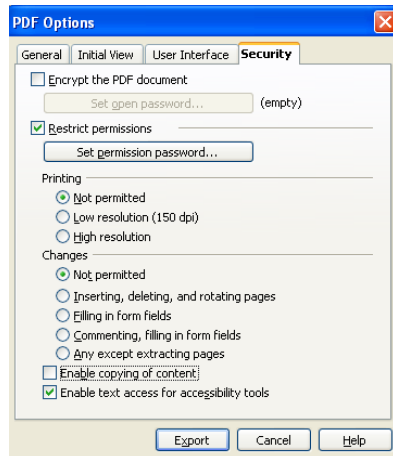
Dictionaries/thesaurus are available online, or via tools that connect to the online version (just like in Microsoft Office), but these are sub-optimal.

Grammar checker is being integrated (October 2006) as it was a Google Summer of Code project that turned into success.

File interoperability with MS Office isn't 100%, but no package can aim to do so, in theory, not even Office:Mac and Office 2003 for instance. File filters like the WordPerfect filter do exist, but are not integrated.

VBA Macros aren't touched. The ability to edit them exists. The ability to run them to a certain extent exists via Novell's OOo.

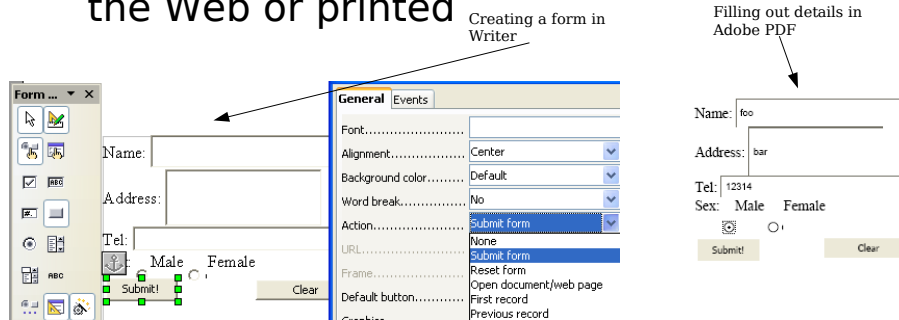
The power of PDF



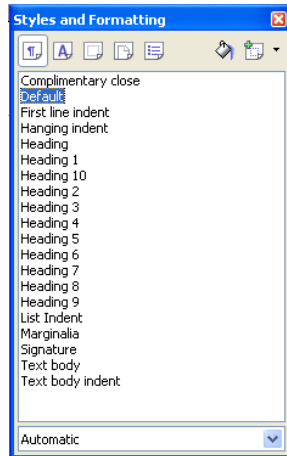
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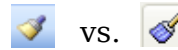
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Get the Stylist via hitting the F11 key

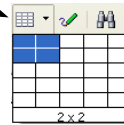
Format Paintbrush is used to copy a style (manually created) and apply it to other parts of the text.

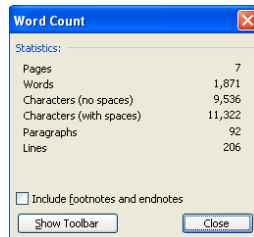
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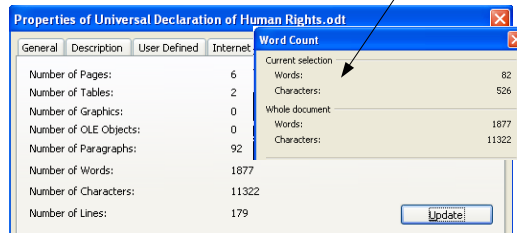

If with all their resources they can't do it right, I have to say that I'm concerned about a package (Calc) put together mostly by volunteer programmers (not statisticians and not numerical analysts, I would presume). This is not to slam those people, but statistics is no place for amateurs, even those copying formulas out of a book.

I would suggest that all statistical functions in Calc be vetted by an computer-experienced statistician, who will run extensive tests and report on weak areas. All functions, especially the statistical functions, should also be examined by someone experienced in numerical computing. At the very, very least, the developers need to find a large suite of tests to thoroughly exercise the code

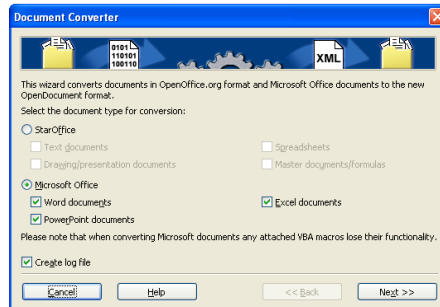
